# HOUSE 1 – Façade Details

1-1. Exterior Wall finish (a) — Textured render and paint Dulux, Teahouse

1-2. Box out
300mmHx400mmD
x
300mmWx400mmD.
Exterior Wall finish
(a) – Textured
render and paint
Dulux, Teahouse

1-3. Widen nib wall to 220mm. Exterior Wall cladding (b) – Modinex, CeraFacade Panel Modern Slit White (to entire nib wall above and below the planterbox)

1-4. Extend bulkhead towards the left ('through' the nib wall) by 700-800mm. Exterior Wall cladding (c) – James Hardie, Matrix cladding. Dulux, Teahouse

1-5. Exterior Wall finish (d) – Brick – Espresso as agreed. (Match Dulux, Black Cavier as closely as possible).

1.6 3x new black downlights into the bulkhead <u>and</u> 3x black downlights into garage lintel



1-7. Exterior Wall finish (d) – Brick – Espresso. 1-8. Planterbox on front/left face of balcony (extends to right side balcony as shown) with clear glass fixed to back face for balustrade. Finish (e) – Render and paint to match Colorbond, Surfmist

1-9. Garage door – Colorbond, Surfmist as per image 1-10. Front door – solid door as shown following with glazed louvre sidelight. Windows above remain full height with solid balustrade inside the house for privacy

1-12. Window reveal – 220-250mmD black as per following image

#### 1-1., 1-2 and 1-4 - Exterior Wall finish (a) and (c) - painted Dulux, Teahouse



1-3. Exterior Wall cladding (b) – Modinex, CeraFacade Panel Modern Slit White



(much lighter in reality, similar to Surfmist)

1-5. and 1-7 Exterior Wall finish (d) — Brick to match Dulux, Black Caviar





1-9. Colorbond, Surfmist garage door



1-10. All window/door joinery to be black. Front door is vertical timber (similar to shown) but painted Dulux, Black Caviar, with glass louvres to the right.









1-12. Black window reveals. Material TBC but will be 220-250mmD and painted/powdercoated black to match window joinery



1-13. Black handrail/balustrade — battens must be thick enough, deep enough and close enough together to avoid the planterbox In front becoming a climable object (liaise with balustrade supplier). Similar to the below. Black powdercoated.

# HOUSE 2 – Façade Details

- 2-1. Exterior Wall finish (g) Brick to match Dulux, Milton Moon as closely as possible. Mortar to be a touch darker than the brick colour
- 2-2. Box out
  400mmHx300mmD x
  400mmWx300mmD.
  Exterior Wall finish (h) –
  Render and paint
  Sufmist to match nib
  wall
- 2-3. Widen nib wall to 220mm. Exterior Wall finish (i) – Cerafacade Modern Slit White from Modinex
- 2-4. Pergola as per following image (black).
  - 2-5. Exterior Wall finish (j) – Render and paint Dulux, Milton Moon



- 2-6. Exterior

  Balustrade
   3x
  frameless

- 2-8. Garage door and surround – flush garage door. Covet, Riigaru Oku or similar
- 2-9. Front door to match garage door with glazed louvre side light. Windows above remain full height with solid balustrade inside the house for privacy
- 2-10. Exterior
  Wall finish (k) –
  Render and paint
  Dulux, Western
  Myall
- 2-11. Lighting add 3x new white downlights into the boxed out area above the Master bedroom door (evenly spaced). Also black wall lights each side of front window.

Note: Main brick for the rest of the house to match the colour Dulux, Milton Moon with mortar to match Dulux, Teahouse. Remaining finishes to be applied around back and sides of house as required.

2-1. Exterior Wall finish (g) - Brick to match Dulux, Milton Moon as closely as possible. Mortar to match Dulux, Teahouse



Similar to this but brick is slightly darker (see below) and mortar matches Dulux, Teahouse





2-3. Exterior Wall cladding (i) – Modinex, CeraFacade Panel Modern Slit White



(much lighter in reality, similar to Surfmist)

2-4.



Pergola is similar to this except that the battens run underneath the soffit, terminating at the wall. Pergola is approx 800mm (front to back) PLUS depth of soffit

2-7. Like this but ideally without a top rail



2-8. Covet, Riigaru Oku



2-9 All window/door joinery to be black. Front door is aluminium 'timber' to match garage door, with glass louvres to the right.



2-10. Exterior Wall finish (k) – Render and paint Dulux, Western Myall



2-11. Black cylindrical wall lights



# HOUSE 1 & 2 – Landscaping, Driveway, Path, Steps, fencing and mailboxes

1/2-1. Dark grey exposed aggregate driveways

1/2-2. Light/Mid Grey travertine style pavers to front steps and landings

1/2-3. Landscaping – Vines here
Japanese Maple here





1/2-4. Planter boxes with cascading plants

1/2-5. Front fences – as per following

1/2-6. Mailboxes – custom built rendered as shown above. Both black






1/2-2. Light/Mid Grey travertine style pavers



1/2-5. Front fences – as shown below. Black posts approx 150x150mm each. Top edge can be sloped to follow the slope of the land.
